

RECYCLING

WHY DO IT?

Recycling saves you and the town money. Every 1% increase in recycling reduces our solid waste disposal cost by 1%. That's your tax \$\$!

It's good for the environment. Many landfills are reaching capacity which leaves future generations with a big problem.

It's easy! Just follow the signs at the transfer station to properly recycle glass, plastic, paper and more.

CO-MINGLE CONTAINERS

- Glass jars and bottles
- All plastic containers #1-7.
 Please remember to remove caps.
- Paper see notes in next column
- Aluminum Cans
- Construction Debris
- Metal

PAPER CONTAINER

- Paper: junk mail, newsprint, magazines, catalogs, phone books, paper bags. (Note: wrapping paper <u>cannot</u> be recycled). No cardboard juice/milk containers.
- Cardboard (remember to flatten boxes). Pizza boxes are OK!

OTHER RECYCLABLES*

Did you know the transfer station can take all types of appliances? These things are known as "white metal".

Plus, we can handle tires, propane tanks and electronics.

DOs and DON'Ts

DO crush ALL tin and aluminum cans as well as cardboard boxes.

DON'T leave unusable goods at the swap shed.

DO follow the directions of transfer station employees and posted signs.

DON'T remove ANYTHING from the transfer station without authorization to do so. This includes, but is not limited to, scrap metals, appliances and cans. The swap shed is an exception.

DO take care of your transfer station. It has to meet the needs of generations to come.

DO be tidy. Please make sure your household trash makes it into the green compactor and doesn't end up on the ground.
