

# Alexandria Selectmen's Meeting Minutes

## February 10, 2015

- **Members Present:** George Tuthill, Donald Sharp and Michael Broome
- The meeting came to order at 6:00 p.m. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.
- The minutes from February 3, 2015 were approved.
- **Items Reviewed and Signed**
  - PA-29 Permanent Application for Property Tax Credit/Exemptions: Map 411 Lot 106
  - Lakes Region Planning Committee Transportation Advisory Committee Appointment Letter
- **Department Heads/Commissions**
  - Alexandria Conservation Commission
    - A letter was read from the ACC to the Selectmen suggesting that they consider using Trout Unlimited for the restoration work that is needed on a portion of Patten Brook; the Selectmen will send a letter to Trout Unlimited requesting that they consider the project.
    - There was discussion regarding a 1971 warrant article that restricted the spraying of certain chemical and the process to prevent National Grid from spraying any chemicals under the power lines.
    - There was a question regarding whether the Selectboard had taken any action on the ACC recommendations for the Bog Road Ordinance; the Selectboard has not made a decision regarding the recommendations.
- **Business**
  - The Selectmen discussed a letter from Lakes Region Public Access Television requesting financial support; no decision was made.
  - The Selectmen discussed a letter from DES regarding their new online permit process for subsurface systems program applications.
  - The Selectmen discussed a letter from NH Department of Revenue Administration regarding the Tax Year 2014 Equalization Rate; the overall equalization assessment-sales ratio for the land, buildings and manufacturing housing in Alexandria for Tax Year 2014 is 112.7%.
  - There was discussion regarding a concern from taxpayer regarding inability to obtain burn permit from fire department and his concerns regarding the Alexandria Volunteer Fire Department; the Selectmen will request that the person come in to discuss his concerns with the Selectmen at one of their meetings.
  - The Selectmen approved AVS having a bake sale at the Town Hall on Election Day.
  - Jennifer reminded the Selectmen that she will be on vacation from February 19 through February 26, 2015. There will be no Selectmen's Meeting on Tuesday, February 24<sup>th</sup>; however, they will still hold a work session at 5:00 pm on that date.
