- Jeff Cantara, Road Agent
 - Mr. Cantara provided an update on Highway Department work progress and vehicle repairs.
 - There was discussion regarding repairs needed to the Cole Hill Road bridge abutments; the Selectmen will review the needed bridge repairs and discuss at their next meeting.
 - Mr. Cantara mentioned that they will be repairing a guard rail on Shem Valley Road.
 - There was discussion regarding doing drainage and ditch work on Thissel Road prior to paving as well as concerns that the draining, ditch work and paving would cost more than the amount raised in the warrant article.
 - There was discussion regarding concerns that damage has been done to Grafton Road and Washburn Road by a logging company; Mr. Cantara sent a letter to the logging company and will contact them to discuss correcting the issue.
 - There was discussion regarding the need to create a driveway culvert replacement policy.

Business

- There was discussion regarding whether the Groton/Alexandria town line survey had been completed; the Town has not received notice that the survey has been completed.
- There was discussion regarding whether or not there was space available in the municipal building to store Conservation Commission files; the Conservation Commission will be notified that there is space in the municipal building for the files.
- There was discussion regarding an email we received about concerns that a logging company was blocking trails on Bear Mountain; it was determined that the logging is not being done in Alexandria.
