    - The Selectmen discussed hazard mitigation plans regarding Patten Brook flooding concerns. They met with an Erin Darrow, Right Angle Engineering, last week to review options to minimize flooding risk. Some of the possibilities discussed include removing the large silt and gravel build-ups in the brook, creating a berm at the edge of the field, and raising Bog Road and the Bog Road Bridge. The Selectmen had also received a proposal from Gabe Bolin, Stone Environmental, for a flood mitigation study. Steve Whitman asked if Trout Unlimited was currently involved in the discussions; Mr. Tuthill stated that they are not currently involved.
