

Alexandria Selectmen's Meeting Minutes

March 6, 2018

- **Members Present:** George Tuthill, Robert Piehler, and Chet Caron
- The meeting came to order at 6:00 p.m. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.
- The minutes of the February 20, 2018 meeting were approved.
- **Items Reviewed and Signed**
 - Abatement Reply: Michael & Louise Hislop (Map 418 Lot 179)
 - Abatement Reply: Daniel & Natalie Milligan (Map 412 Lot 43)
 - Junkyard License: Carter Morrison, Map 418 Lot 224

- **Business**
 - The Selectmen reviewed a letter from NH DOT regarding their new Oversize/Overweight permitting software system that includes the ability for towns to participate in management of oversize/overweight travel including processing permits and managing restrictions on roads and bridges within their jurisdiction. The Selectmen would like to review this information with Jeff Cantara, Road Agent before making a decision to participate.
 - The Selectmen reviewed a letter from Archie Auger regarding concerns with including capital improvement items the Newfound Area School District 2018/2019 default budget.
 - The Selectmen discussed findings from Central Land Surveying regarding ownership of an 8 acre lot on Plumer Hill Road that is currently listed in our system with an unknown owner. The Selectmen requested obtaining input from Town Counsel.
 - There was discussion regarding whether the town or the state inspects licensed junkyards in town. Michael Provost, Health Officer, expressed concerns about a property on Fowler River Road and proper vehicle fluid removal and safety.
 - Mr. Tuthill announced that the 2017 Annual Report and the 2018 Voting Guide are available in the Municipal Building and that voting day is Tuesday, March 13, 2018 from 11:00 am to 7:00 pm.
- **Department Heads/Committees**
 - George Clayman, Emergency Management Director and Fire chief
 - Mr. Clayman said that the Hazard Mitigation Plan is almost finalized and is pending approval from FEMA.
 - The new door for the fire station will be installed this spring.
 - Mr. Clayman said that the fire department has been successful in recruiting new members and setting them up with training.
- **Public Input**
 - Michael Provost stated that the Budget Committee needs right in candidates on the ballot. He said that Ken Braley, Sr., Doug Benton, Ed Skrobak, and Janet Towse are interested in being written in on the ballot for budget committee.
