

Alexandria Selectmen's Meeting Minutes

July 31, 2018

- **Members Present:** George Tuthill, Robert Piehler, and Chet Caron
- The meeting came to order at 6:00 p.m. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.
- The minutes from the July 17, 2018 meeting were approved.
- **Items Reviewed and Signed**
 - Letter requesting extension of grant for Fowler River Road culvert replacement
 - PA-29 Application for Property Tax Credit/Exemptions (Map 417 Lot 39)
 - Property Tax Agreement: Geiger Map 407 Lot 90
 - Property Tax Agreement: Tomasello Map 409 Lot 11
 - Property Tax Agreement: Stone Map 409 Lot 10
 - DOT Municipal Work Zone Agreement
- **Business**
 - The Selectmen reviewed a letter from NH Interlocal Trust explaining that they did not bill the town the correct rate for the 2016-2017 year. The Trust has written off the approximately \$13,000 in premiums the Town was not billed. The Town will see an 11% increase in insurance rates for the 2018-2019 year. Since the employees were told that there would be no increase in health insurance costs to them for the year, the Selectmen made the decision to have the town cover the increased cost.
 - The Selectmen reviewed a letter from State Senator Bob Guida regarding an informational session and tour of the Bridgewater Power Plant on Thursday, August 9th at 1:00 pm to provide an opportunity to learn about Governor Sununu's vetoes of SB 365 and SB446.
 - The Selectmen discussed an email from Earl Beshong regarding the letter they sent to him about monitoring the status of a culvert on McMurphy Road; the Selectmen will review the situation with Jeff Cantara, Road Agent.
 - The paving of Town Pound Road was postponed due to rain last week; the date of paving is not certain.
- **Department Heads/Commissions**
 - Michael Provost, Health Officer
 - Mr. Provost requested that the Selectmen send a letter to a property owner at 219 Perkins Hill Road regarding junkyard violations.
 - Mr. Provost is extending time for the property owner at 378 Smith River Road to continue cleaning up the property before having the Selectmen send them a letter.
