

Alexandria Selectmen's Meeting Minutes

September 18, 2018

- **Members Present:** Chet Caron and Robert Piehler
- The meeting came to order at 6:00 p.m. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.
- The minutes from the September 4, 2018 meeting were approved.
- **Items Reviewed and Signed**
 - Purchase Order: drag shim Karl Gordon Road
 - Cemetery Deed: Riverside Lots 135-C, 135-D, 135-E
 - Veteran's Credit Application: Map 412 Lot 36
 - Agreement between Town of Alexandria and George E. Sansoucy, PE, LLC to provide general consulting and revaluation services for utilities regarding the Eversource abatement appeal.
 - Letter to Newfound Lake Region Association regarding funds for stormwater management for a project on Shem Valley Road
- **Items Reviewed for Signature**
 - The Selectmen reviewed the lease for the new cruiser. Since the paperwork from Ford Credit listed Selectmen Tuthill's name, Mr. Caron and Mr. Piehler authorized Mr. Tuthill to sign the paperwork.
- **Department Heads/Committees**
 - Jeff Cantara, Road Agent
 - Mr. Cantara discussed work being done to drainage on Shem Valley Road; the work should be completed by the end of September.
 - Mr. Cantara plans to begin fall grading on October 1st and will start in the north part of town.
 - Mr. Cantara and the Selectmen discussed concerns about damage done to a portion of the class VI section of Knowles Hill Road by loggers; the loggers will be contacted to request that they repair the damage.
 - The furnace in the shop that heats the bathroom, office and break room area is not working and parts are not available to fix it; Mr. Cantara is obtaining estimates to replace the furnace.
 - Steve Whitman, Alexandria Waste Management Committee
 - Mr. Whitman address concerned about the Town's current recycling program. He said that recycling processors are putting more restrictions on what they will accept and this is impacting the cost to recycle. The committee will provide the Selectmen with recommendations for the recycling program before the next Selectmen's meeting.
 - Michael Provost, Health Officer
 - The owner of 378 Smith River Road requested a 30-day extension to clean up the property; the Selectmen and Mr. Provost agreed to the 30-day extension.
 - Mr. Provost reported that the owner of 219 Perkins Hill Road said he is making progress in removing vehicles; Mr. Provost will inspect the property at the end of the month.
