❖ **Business**

- After reviewing estimates received for the new loader, the Selectmen selected the bid from Beauregard; a purchase order and quote agreement for the loader and equipment for the loader was signed.
- Mr. Tuthill stated that there was a good turnout on town voting day and thanked residents for voting.

❖ **Department Heads**

- Chief Donald Sullivan
 - Chief Sullivan said that he is expecting the delivery of vests that were purchased with funds donated by Mr. Raptis.
 - Chief Sullivan expressed concerns that the police department does not have adequate space and concerned with safety while booking people. Chief Sullivan is requesting that the police department expand into the planning board office area. There was discussion concerning alternative locations for planning board records.
 - Chief Sullivan advised the Selectmen that state police for troop F no longer has officers on duty overnight. As a result of this change, Alexandria officers will be on call overnight.

- There was discussion regarding increased arrest rates and that the increased rates are partially due to the recent bail reform.
