

Alexandria Selectmen's Meeting Minutes

April 30, 2019

- ❖ **Members Present:** George Tuthill, Chet Caron and Robert Piehler
 - The meeting came to order at 6:00 p.m. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.
 - The minutes from the April 16, 2019 meeting were approved.
- ❖ **Items for Reviewed & Signed**
 - Purchase Order: Maquire Equipment for 45 yard container
 - Purchase Order: Jordan Equipment for front mount york rake
 - Purchase Order: Code Red alert system
 - George Clayman, EMD and Fire Chief, explained that this service provides a means for the Town to reach out to citizens in an emergency situation as well as including the ability to opt in to receive community event alerts.
 - Purchase Order: Industrial Protection Services: FD ventilation fan
 - Avitar Agreement: Clerk motor vehicle software-add boat module
 - Notice of Intent to Cut: H&H Investments – multiple lots & letter regarding Braley Hill Road access
- ❖ **Business**
 - The Selectmen discussed an incident at the transfer station regarding a resident that was upset and confrontational when a fee for construction debris was requested. The Selectmen will be discussing handling situations such as this with the transfer station supervisor.
 - Additional FEMA reimbursement for the October 2017 storm event will be disbursed once the state receives an invoice covering expenses from the town. There will be funding available for additional work to some of the roads, but that amount is pending additional discussion with the state.
 - The Selectmen discussed a complaint on damage to a fence at 332 Bailey Road; the Selectmen will contact the resident and view the damage to determine if any corrective action needs to be taken.
- ❖ **Department Heads/Committees**
 - Jeff Cantara, Road Agent
 - Grading on the roads has been postponed at least a week due to wet road conditions.
 - Paving will potentially begin late June; pricing increases for paving after July 15th, but the increase is minimal. Paving projects include finishing Cass Mill Road, part of Washburn Road to bridge, and a section of Fowler River Road.
- ❖ **Public Input**
 - Kent and Maureen Towers, Fletcher Farm Road, offered to donate \$2,000 to the town for gravel for a section of Bog Road; the Selectmen held off a decision pending further discussion. After discussing the amount of traffic Bog Road receives, road damage and the cost to repair the road, there was discussion on closing the section of Bog Road between the gates or making Bog Road a one-way road.
