  - The meeting came to order at 6:00 p.m. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

  - Tony Brown, Transfer Station Supervisor
    - Mr. Brown attended the Selectmen's meeting to address concerns received regarding transfer station staff and operating hours. Mr. Brown read the attached letter at the meeting.
    - Mr. Brown expressed concern with contractors bringing items to the transfer station without the proper permit.
  - Jeff Cantara, Road Agent
    - Mr. Cantara provided an update on Highway Department activity. Spring grading is ongoing; they are on Washburn, move to Burns Hill Road, and then the north end of town.
- ❖ **Public Input**
  - Michael Provost thanked the Alexandria Fire Department, Bristol Fire Department, and Chief Clayman for their response to a medical call.
