

Alexandria Selectmen's Meeting Minutes

June 18, 2019

- ❖ **Members Present:** George Tuthill, Chet Caron and Robert Piehler
 - The meeting came to order at 6:00 p.m. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.
- The minutes from the June 4, 2019 meeting were approved.

- ❖ **Business**
 - King Road/Burns Hill Road Intersection
 - The Selectmen reviewed signed changes made by Jeff Cantara, Road Agent, as a result of safety concerns of the King Road/Burns Hill Road intersection. The stop sign at the end of Burns Hill Road was moved and a "Stop Ahead" sign added; a yield sign was placed on King Road near the intersection heading south.
 - Mr. Beshong's concerns with McMurphy Road maintenance near his property
 - After discussing the condition of the area near Mr. Beshong's property, the Selectmen determined that any perceived damage was done as a result of regular winter road maintenance within the road right-of-way and they are not inclined to take any action on the matter. They suggested that if Mr. Beshong has continuing concerns, he should attend a meeting with the Selectmen to discuss them.
 - Mr. Tuthill suggested that the Selectmen review proposed changes to the Financial Policy at the next Selectmen's meeting.
 - The Selectmen discussed a request to waive the town hall rental fee for a party for Bob Cantara; the Selectmen agreed to waive the fee.
- ❖ **Department Heads/Commissions**
 - Jeff Cantara Road Agent
 - Mr. Cantara provided an update on highway department activities. The lighting project at the highway garage has been completed and works better than the old lighting. Delays in grading were due to the grader requiring repairs and spring grading will continue in the next few weeks. There will be a few days when they will be unable to grade the roads as they assist and prepare roads for paving.
