

# Alexandria Selectmen's Meeting Agenda

## October 1, 2019

- ❖ **Members Present:** George Tuthill, Chet Caron, and Robert Piehler
- ❖ The meeting came to order at 6:00 p.m. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.
- ❖ The minutes from the September 17, 2019 meeting were approved.
- ❖ **Items Reviewed & Signed**
  - Timber Tax: Map 420 Lot 28 Flanders
  - PA-29 Property Tax Credit/Exemption: Map 418 Lot 168
  - Notice of Intent to Cut: Map 404 Lot 11/Welton Falls State Forest
- ❖ **Appointments**
  - Trustees of Trust Funds/Cemetery Trustees
    - Doug Benton and Sue Cheney discussed sill repairs to the hearse house; they will be pursuing estimates for the repair work. There are funds in the Crawford trust for repairs. There was also discussion on building a shed for the carriage house in behind the municipal building; no decision was made.
  - Jeff Cantara, Road Agent.
    - Mr. Cantara provided an update on highway department activities. Grading will begin the week of October 7<sup>th</sup>. Mr. Cantara expressed concerns that roads are dry due to lack of rain and it requires the use of a water truck. Winter sand has been delivered and stacked. Shoulder gravel work has been completed. He expressed his appreciation for patience on some of the routine road maintenance as the highway department time was heavily consumed by the Fowler River Road box culvert project in August.
- ❖ **Business**
  - Mr. Tuthill announced Jennifer Tuthill's resignation from the Alexandria Conservation Commission.
  - Michael Provost asked the Selectmen about problems with the videos on the public access channel; the concerns will be addressed with the provider.
