

Alexandria Selectmen's Meeting Minutes

December 3, 2019

- ❖ The meeting came to order at 6:00 p.m. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.
- ❖ The minutes for November 19, 2019 were approved
- ❖ **Items Reviewed & Signed**
 - Plodzik & Sanderson Audit Agreement for Year Ending December 31 2019
 - Purchase Order 1042: Thefirestore.com for rope & rescue gear
- ❖ **Business**
 - The Selectmen discussed the landowner complaint regarding drainage from a culvert near his property at 490 Washburn Road; no further action will be taken by the town at this time.
 - The Selectmen reviewed the request from two property owners that are interest in donating land to the Town for conservation purposes. The lots include Map 414 Lot 56 and Map 414 Lot 19. The Selectmen requested that the information be provided to the Alexandria Conservation Commission for their opinion on the value of those properties as conservation properties. A concern was brought up regarding a fifty foot right of way that goes through the middle of Map 414 Lot 56 that may impede conservation efforts.
 - The Selectmen announced that a public hearing will be held on Tuesday, December 17th following the Selectmen's meeting at 6:00 pm to review the proposed building notification form.
 - The Selectmen authorized holiday bonuses for town employees.
 - Jeff Cantara, Road Agent, provided a reminder for property owners that the town has a policy against plowing snow over the road and emphasized the hazards that plowing snow over the roadway causes.
