- Mr. Tuthill thanked those that attended the Deliberative Session on February 1, 2020.
- ➤ The Selectmen reviewed a letter from Dilys Morris requesting to be appointed to Conservation Commission. The Selectmen said that the Conservation Commission will be providing a list of individuals that recommend for appointment to the Conservation Commission.
- ➤ The Selectmen reviewed a letter from Jacob Goodrum (490 Washburn Road) regarding his concerns about water run off on his property; this is an ongoing concern and legal counsel will be consulted.
- There was discussion regarding finding out what steps can be taken to put town-owned land, such as Barrett Park and piece on Bog Road, into some sort of protection from any future sale or development.
- Mr. Caron said that he spoke with Boake Morrison regarding the current transfer station land lease. Mr. Caron mentioned that Mr. Morrison would be interested in selling the piece of land the transfer station is currently on and does not have any plans on not renewing our current lease agreement. There was some discussion on moving the transfer station in the future and estimated cleaning costs for that site. Ken Hall said that there is trash that has accumulated over the embankment at the back side of the transfer station. There was a suggestion to look into having inmates assist with the clean up.
- Mr. Piehler said that Jim Grant has volunteered to look at the road layouts for the town to review them. There was discussion on adopting layouts of some of the roads that Colin Brown had previously surveyed.
- > Nancy Whitman informed the Selectmen that Deb Glidden has been added as a new member of the Town Hall Preservation Committee.
