

Alexandria Selectmen's Meeting Minutes

March 27, 2020

- ❖ **Members Present:** George Tuthill, Chet Caron and Robert Piehler
- ❖ The meeting came to order at 8:00 a.m. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.
- ❖ **Items Reviewed & Signed**
 - Timber Tax: Map 411-112 & 411-51 Joan W Smith 1998 Trust
 - Excavation Tax: Map 411 Lot 132-2 William & Ann Hall
 - Notice of Intent to Excavate: Map 411 Lot 132-2 William & Ann Hall
 - Purchase Order: Hansen Bridge/Bailey Road Bridge
 - The vendor was changed for the bridge due to weight concerns with the existing abutments.
 - Fire Equipment Expendable Trust Fund: Request for funds to be dispersed to pay for repairs to the pump on Engine 2
 - Notice of Intent to Cut: Map 420 Lot 23
 - Application PA-29: Elderly Exemption Map 411 Lot 109
- ❖ **Business**
 - Governor Sununu's Emergency Order #17 Pursuant to Executive Order 2020-04: Closure of non-essential businesses and requiring Granite Staters to stay at home
 - The Selectmen discussed the Governor's Emergency Order #17 and any potential impact on town services. The following has been implemented:
 - Town Hall is closed to the public but all services are still available during normal business hours via phone, email, or online. Appointments with staff can be made as necessary.
 - Transfer Station employees will be advised to limit interactions with the public and will be provided additional disinfectant/sanitizers and gloves.
 - Highway Department staff is increasing the cleaning of equipment between uses and keeping appropriate distances. To limit exposure, Mr. Cantara stated that they are operating on a day-to-day basis regarding hours worked.
 - Options are being explored for online meetings with call-in options for future Selectmen's meetings. The next Selectmen's Meeting will be held on Tuesday, April 7, 2020 at 6:00 pm. The meeting scheduled for Tuesday, March 31, 2020 has been cancelled.
 - George Tuthill expressed concern regarding hardship for tax payments when the next tax bills are sent out since all non-essential businesses have been closed.
