

# Alexandria Selectmen's Meeting Minutes

## November 2, 2021

- ❖ The meeting came to order at 6:00 p.m. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.
- ❖ The minutes from the October 19, 2021 meeting were approved.

- ❖ **Appointment**
  - Donald Sharp
    - Mr. Sharp was present to discuss a water drainage problem on Church Hill Road onto Knowles Hill Road and Mr. Sharp's property. There was discussion regarding increased water as a result of logging and development on Church Hill Road. Mr. Sharp suggested putting a culvert in to divert some water on Church Hill Road. The Selectmen, Mr. Sharp, and Paul Sirard will meet at 4:30 pm on November 3, 2021 to review the area and discuss ways to address the drainage concerns.
- ❖ **Business**
  - The Selectmen reviewed interest expressed from David June to participate in the Broadband Committee; the Selectmen requested he be thanked for his interest in participating.
  - Kerry Rockwell informed the Selectmen that there is a program to get a discounted bill from Atlantic Broadband for internet access through the Emergency Broadband Benefit program by visiting [atlanticbb.cm/ebb](http://atlanticbb.cm/ebb).
  - Mr. Tuthill explained that a representative from NH Fish & Game met with the Alexandria Conservation Commission at Barrett Park on Bog Road to discuss ways to protect the turtle nesting in the area. One of the recommendations includes limiting traffic on the property and putting up signs to discourage disturbance to the nesting area; the Selectmen were in favor of putting up signs.
  - Nancy Whitman provided an update on the status of painting of the Town Hall. Two sides have been completed and the grange sign has been removed for restoration.
