- Keith Bruning discussed with the Selectmen the increase in fees at the transfer station that were set at the last Selectmen's meeting. The Selectmen expressed that the fees were adjusted as discussed with Ken Hall, Transfer Station Supervisor, and that Mr. Bruning should discuss it with his supervisor. Mr. Bruning also questioned why disposal fees collected at the transfer station are put into the general fund. It was explained to Mr. Bruning that disposal fees are general revenue of the town and the town has one fund into which all revenues are deposited.
