Business

> The Selectmen reviewed a warrant article petition that would modify the funding model for the Newfound Area School District. Mr. Tuthill read the article as follows:

To: School Board of the Newfound Area School District ("the District"), serving the Towns of Alexandria, Bridgewater, Bristol, Danbury, Groton, Hebron, and New Hampton, New Hampshire ("the Towns") The undersigned registered voters in the Towns petition the School Board of the District to place the following warrant article on the Warrant for the March, 2022 District Annual Meeting for the purpose of reapportioning capital outlay costs and operational costs for the District as provided for in this petition:

Are you in favor of the adoption of Article number ____ as proposed by this petition to reapportion capital outlay costs and operational costs for the Newfound Area School District as follows:

Article____To see if the Voters of the Newfound Area School District ("the District") will vote to adopt the following formula to reapportion the capital outlay costs and operational costs ("Costs") for the District pursuant to NH RSA 195:8 so that the new apportionment formula shall be: one-half of all Costs shall be apportioned on the basis of the ratio that the equalized valuation of each preexisting District Member Town bears to that of the District as a whole for the preceding calendar year; and the other half of all Costs shall be apportioned on the basis of the ratio of the average daily attendance of each District Member Town bears to that of the District as a whole for the preceding school year pursuant to NH RSA 195:7 I.(b).

- Concerns were expressed that modifying the funding model may result in some communities choosing to leave the school district. Mr. Tuthill explained that there is no way to predict the full impact changing the funding model will have on the school district.
- The petitioned warrant article will be circulated for signatured of registered voters within the school district.
- The Selectmen reviewed the elderly exemption amounts and income limits that are currently in place in Alexandria. After discussing the exemption amounts, the Selectmen decided to include an article in the 2022 warrant to increase the amount of the exemptions as follows:
 - Ages 65 to 74 increase exemption from \$27,500 to \$35,000
 - Ages 75 to 89 increase exemption from \$42,000 to \$50,000
 - Ages 80+ increase exemption from \$61,000 to \$70,000

After reviewing the current set income and asset limits (\$20,500 for single and \$30,000 for married both with \$64,000 asset limit), the Selectmen were not inclined to change the asset and income limits.

The Selectmen reviewed and approved the updated solid waste fee schedule as follows:
