

## Snow Plowing Ordinance Plowing of Snow into Roadways

To promote the safe and orderly passage of the motoring public on the Town's roads, free from obstructions and obstacles created by the removal or depositing of snow, the Town of Alexandria hereby adopted the following ordinance on 3/1/22.

No person shall by himself or by his agent or agents throw, push or put any snow or ice into or across any and all Town roads, including Class V and Class VI, or to deposit snow within the traveled portions of Town roads by any means including, but not limited to, plowing, snow blowing, and shoveling. This also prohibits the cleaning off of cars that result in depositing snow onto the roadway.


Across any and all Town roads shall mean pushing snow from one side of the road to the other where snow would be deposited within the right-of-way of any road.


Traveled portion shall mean any part of the roadway in which vehicles would travel or within the shoulders of said roadway.


Any person who violates the provisions of the Snow Plowing Ordinance shall:

- Receive written warning for first offense
- Subsequent offenses shall be subject to a fine of \$25 for each occurrence
