

Alexandria Selectmen's Meeting Minutes

August 29, 2023

- ❖ **Members Present:** George Tuthill, Chet Caron and Robert Piehler
- ❖ The meeting came to order at 6:00 p.m. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.
- ❖ The minutes from the August 15, 2023 meeting were approved.
- ❖ **The following items were discussed and signed**
 - PA-29: Permanent Application for Property Tax Credit/Exemption Map 411 Lot 127
 - Purchase Order 45: Morrison Construction for storm damage repair from June 25th an 26th
 - Purchase Order 47: Town of Bristol for Community TV Access 2023
 - MS-1 Summary Inventory of Valuation for 2023
 - MS-535 Financial Report of the Budget 2023
- ❖ **Business**
 - The Selectmen reviewed a resident request for speed limit sign to be placed on the Bog Road end of Karl Gordon Road; Paul Sirard, Road Agent, stated that the sign was placed in that location last week.
 - The Selectmen reviewed a resident concern with speeding on Washburn Road near the intersection of North Road, Bog Road, and Town Pound Road. The resident requested signage to encourage people to drive slower and use caution. There was discussion on placing signs that say caution children ahead or school in session please drive slowly. That section of Washburn Road is a state road and the state DOT would need to be contacted about placing signs.
 - The Selectmen are getting ready to close on financing for the new transfer station. Jim Shokal met with the Selectmen and Road Agent to review the site and determine the first steps for preparing for construction.
 - Ventilation fans will be installed in the basement of the town hall next week.
 - The Town has not received an update from FEMA regarding a disaster declaration for the June storms that caused road damage.
 - Mr. Sirard will call AMC to set up a meeting to discuss parking along the side of Shem Valley Road.
 - Mr. Caron expressed concerns about the tattered flag at island on the intersection of Washburn Road, Bog Road, North Road, and Town Pound Road. A new flag will be ordered to replace the damaged flag.
