

Alexandria Selectmen's Meeting Minutes

March 5, 2024

- ❖ **Members Present:** George Tuthill, Chet Caron and Robert Piehler
- ❖ The meeting came to order at 6:00 p.m. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.
- ❖ The minutes from the February 20, 2024 meeting were approved.
- ❖ **The following items were discussed and signed**
 - Letter to USDA regarding application
 - Junkyard License: Morrison Map 418 Lot 224
 - PA-29 Permanent Application for Property Tax Credit/Exemption: Map 407 Lot 21-1
 - Application for Temporary Relief from Road Weight Limits: Jake Goodrum
- ❖ **Business**
 - Jennifer Tuthill, Alexandria Conservation Commission
 - Colin Brown has finished the survey of Barrett Park Turtle Preserve on Bog Road. Ms. Tuthill stated that the fee for the survey will be paid out of the Conservation Commission's Conservation Fund.
 - Mrs. Tuthill asked if the CARE Group had donated funds to the Alexandria Conservation Commission; the Town has not yet received funds and will inform the ACC if they are received.
 - The Conservation Commission would like to walk the property owned by the Town on Smith River Road and review ideas for use with the Selectmen.
 - The Conservation Commission would like to obtain more information about a 12 acre lot owned by the town off of Morrison Road and the possibility of adding it to conservation land. The Selectmen will look into obtaining quiet title of the property to confirm ownership; the property was taken by the town via tax deed.
 - Reminder that voting day is March 12, 2024 at town hall, 45 Washburn Road, with polls open from 11 am to 7 pm.
 - Annual reports are available online, at the transfer station, and in the municipal building.
 - The Selectmen discussed concerns about the mud conditions on Burns Hill Road and King Road. Paul Sirard, Road Agent, stated that the highway department has been working on improving the conditions on those roads.
 - The Selectmen discussed a resident's concerns with drainage of water from town property onto their property on Smith River Road. The Selectmen have requested the engineer review drainage on the property.
 - Nany Whitman requested permission to hold a bake sale on voting day to raise funds to provide to Nikki Wooster-Goodwin for the town Easter Egg Hunt that she is arranging; the Selectmen approved the bake sale.
 - Mr. Piehler mentioned he attended a presentation done by UNH at the Hill Library about wildlife.
