- Hubb66 Representatives
 - Andrea Vient and Michael Mateja from Hubb66 were present to discuss fiber broadband expansion in Alexandria. There are two levels of project funding that they are pursuing, one through the state and the other through the county. They requested letters of support from the town for the projects; the Selectmen agreed to provide letters of support.
 - The next steps in getting Hub66 set up with a station at the town hall will be to provide keys to access the area in the town hall for set up. Hub66 has obtained pole license agreements to attach to Eversource poles to bring service to the town hall.

 - The Alteration of Terrain Permit for the transfer station is complete and has been submitted to NH DES.
- There was a brief discussion on the status of the school district; no update is available until Hebron votes in May.
