September 3, 2024

- ❖ **Members Present:** George Tuthill, Chet Caron, and Robert Piehler
- ❖ The meeting came to order at 6:00 p.m. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.
- ❖ The minutes from the August 20, 2024 meeting were approved.
- ❖ **The following items were discussed and signed**
 - Cemetery Deed: Riverside Plot 191-C
 - Cemetery Deed: Riverside Plots 136-A, 136-B, 136-C, 136-D, 136-E, 136-F
 - Building Notification: Addition on house at Map 411 Lot 138
- ❖ **Business**
 - Transfer Station Update
 - The Selectmen discussed the estimates received for site work and the building for the new transfer station. The following items were signed:
 - Purchase order for site work: SKR Site Services
 - Purchase order for building: Construx, Inc.
 - Calley Road
 - The Selectmen received a request from Casey Gordon, E911 Field Representative, NH DOS, to change the name of Calley Road due to issues with delivery services as a result of there also being a Calley Road in Bridgewater with the same zip code. The Selectmen agreed to move forward with changing the road name to Calley Way.
 - The Selectmen accepted a donation of Bog School House sign and drawing from Stephen Miller.
 - Town Hall Preservation
 - Nancy Whitman provided an update on the electrical work that has been done at the old town hall. There is still some electrical work to be done and the basement fans need to be installed.
 - Mrs. Whitman announced that there will be a bake sale to benefit town hall preservation during the state primary.
 - The Selectmen provided a reminder that the state primary is Tuesday, September 10, 2024 at the old town hall with polls open from 8 am to 7 pm.
 - The Selectmen discussed attending a meeting with the Bristol Selectmen to discuss ways in which the communities can work together.
 - There was also a brief discussion on the status of the school district.
