

Alexandria Selectmen's Meeting Minutes

March 3, 2026

- ❖ **Members Present:** George Tuthill, Chet Caron and Robert Piehler
- ❖ The meeting came to order at 6:00 pm and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited.
- ❖ The minutes from February 17, 2026 were approved.
- ❖ Mr. Tuthill and Mr. Piehler thanked Chet Caron for his nine years of service as a Select Board member.
- ❖ **Items Reviewed and Signed**
 - Junkyard License Certificate of Renewal: Map 418 Lot 224 Morrison
- ❖ **New Business**
 - Reminder: Town Voting Day is March 10, 2026 with polls open from 11 am to 7 pm
 - FEMA Flood Insurance Rate Maps: Workmap review
 - The Select Board invite to attend workmap meeting (online) for Tuesday, March 17, 2026. There has been an updated engineering analysis on several river reaches in Town and USGS would like the Town to review the workmaps.
- ❖ **Old Business**
 - Map 414 Lot 89 land off Morrison Road
 - Town-owned property taken via tax deed in 2019. There has been discussion on putting property into conservation and the Select Board has requested input from the Conservation Commission regarding a management plan; the Select Board are waiting for the Conservation Commissions input. There was discussion on whether there was any access to the lot; there is a right of way off the end of Morrison Road.
 - AMC/Shem Valley Road Parking
 - Mr. Tuthill read a drafted letter to the NH Division of Forests and Lands regarding Mount Cardigan trail parking concerns. It was expressed that the AMC has addressed parking concerns at the lodge by making the parking lot area larger and providing a turnaround area for town equipment. There have been ongoing issues with day hikers using the state park parking along the side of Shem Valley Road and the entrance to Clark Trail; the Road Agent has put up signs that state "No parking for 3 miles" along that section of Shem Valley Road.
 - The Select Board signed the letter to the NH Division of Forests and Lands requesting an update on any increased parking plans and requesting a meeting with them to discuss.
- ❖ **Public Input**
 - Richard Nialetz would like to provide a donation of \$1,371 to the library; the Select Board stated that they will accept the donation.
 - Mr. Piehler inquire whether the American Legion had contacted legal counsel regarding setting up a trust to assist with cemetery stone maintenance; Mr. Nialetz said that they had not yet met with an attorney.
