

Alexandria Selectmen's Meeting Minutes

July 21, 2026

- ❖ **Members Present:** George Tuthill, Robert Piehler and Brian Lewis
- ❖ The meeting came to order at 6:00 pm and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited.
- ❖ Approval of Minutes from July 7, 2026
- ❖ **Items Reviewed and Signed**
 - Building Notification: Map 11 Lot 36 2-bedroom home on Patten Road
 - PA-16: Application for Reimbursement to Towns and Cities in which Federal and State Forest Land is Situated 2026
- ❖ **Business/Appointments**
 - Condolences were expressed to the Platts family for the loss of Fred Platts and expressed appreciation for all he did for the community.
 - LED Street Lighting Proposal from Affinity LED Lighting
 - The Select Board discussed the proposal for replacing 13 street lights in town with LED fixtures; the proposal from Affinity LED Lighting is for \$8,908.81 before an Eversource Energy Efficiency Incentive of \$1,300. Shaun Lagueux stated that the Town of Bristol's street lighting was replaced with LED fixtures by Affinity almost 5 years ago and he was unaware of any problems. The Select Board would like to meet with representatives from Affinity LED Lighting to further discuss the project.
 - NH DOT will be replacing a culvert near the intersection of Fowler River Road and Bailey Road. There was discussion on whether this was to prepare the roads for paving by the state.
 - Michael Provost, Health Officer
 - Mr. Provost sent a letter to the property owner at the end of Morrison Road regarding items being parked and stored in the turn around area of Morrison Road that need to be removed.
 - Mr. Provost reported that there has not been much change to the property at 367 Welton Falls Road and is waiting for the court response. It was reported that it appears that the property may be hooked up to the power grid, potentially meaning that there would no longer be a need for them to run the generators.
 - The Select Board and Road Agent discussed a property owners concern regarding the condition of Washburn Road; the complaint was made in the middle of road maintenance. Mr. Sirard and Mr. Piehler have been on the road and do not feel that there are any deficiencies. The individual also inquired on how to have the road agent be appointed versus elected. Mrs. Dostie explained that the individual was told the Select Board would assess the road condition and the process for submitting a petitioned warrant article.
 - Shaun Lagueux informed the Select Board that NHDOT will be redoing the deck on the Route 104 bridge between New Hampton and Bristol.
 - Mr. Lagueux inquired whether the Select Board would like to engage his services to assess trees in the right-of-way on town roads that may be in danger of falling. The Select Board will further discuss the matter to determine if they want to proceed.
