

Alexandria Selectmen's Meeting Minutes

September 15, 2026

- ❖ The meeting came to order at 6:00 pm and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited.
- ❖ Approval of Minutes from August 18, 2026
- ❖ **Items Reviewed and Signed**
 - Affinity LED agreement and purchase order for street light upgrades to LED
 - Building Notification: Morse Map 413 Lot 99.3 on King Road for house
 - Building Notification: Morse Map 413 Lot 99.2 on King Road for garage with apartment
 - Building Notification: Rogers Map 418 Lot 190 on Berry Farms Road for outbuilding
 - PA-29 Application for Property Tax Credits/Exemptions Map 411 Lot 38
 - Land Use Change Tax: Schaffner Map 407 Lot 41
- ❖ **Business/Appointments**
 - Alexandria Village School furnace replacement
 - The Select Board discussed the estimate received for the furnace replacement at the Alexandria Village School. Several businesses were contacted for estimates over the last few months and only one was received. The cost will be covered from funds in the school trust; the Select Board stated that the decision to replace the furnace will be made by the Trustees.
 - The Select Board discussed a notice received that the NH Department of Transportation will be resurfacing Cass Mill Road, Washburn Road, Fowler River Road, and North Road (4.6 miles).
 - The Select Board discussed an offer made to purchase the Old Fire Truck for \$1,500.
 - Lynn Avenue
 - Several property owners that live on Lynn Avenue attended the meeting to discuss the process for having the town take over maintenance of Lynn Avenue. The property owners expressed concerns with how the subdivision was approved and subsequently expanded in the late 1990's/early 2000's as well as concerns with building permits and driveway permits issues in the early 2000's. There was additional discussion on whether the campground on the road was approved for year-round living and if there were tax rebates that were supposed to go to property owners after the reclamation of the Bedard gravel pit on the road. The Select Board will review planning board files on the subdivision to get more background information and provided the property owners with a handout with guidelines for petitioning to layout a town road.
